

Hand Carry Procedures

In the course of doing business, a sales person, researcher, service technician or marketing executive may find a need to hand carry demonstrations sets, samples, spare parts and/or accessories to other countries. Traders should be aware of the administrative requirements of such activities in order to avoid stoppage at Customs, penalties and fines.

Declare Import/Export Permit

- Customs in various countries have different regulations that dictate when a permit needs to be declared
- This is usually dependent on quantity or value of cargo
- If necessary, the trader should engage a broker to declare the required permit

Furnish Documents to Customs

- The trader must proceed to furnish all documents and present the item to Customs at the originating and destination countries
- This typically requires the trader to find the Customs office
- Submitting documents at the immigration counter for hand carry cargo is usually not accepted

Apply for the right type of Permit

If the trader intends to return to origin carrying the same item, a temporary export permit should be taken in order to avoid paying import duties upon return.
